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ELIGIBILITY: Grades 9 to 12

RULES:

- Each school is allowed to send only **one team.**
- Each participating school can enter a team consisting of five to eight members.
- One participant from each team will be responsible for assisting the logistics team with the lighting during the performance (in addition to the specified number of members).
- Each participating team must **select a specific country** or cultural region as the inspiration for their collection.
- Each participant's outfit must have at least 2-3 clothing items/accessories that they have made themselves.
- Each member of the team must walk the ramp in their respective outfits.
- Each performance must not exceed 3 minutes.
- Each team is required to submit clear pictures of the items they made on Google Slides. It must be emailed to panache@bombayscottish.in by 10PM on Monday, 29th July 2024. (Title for your respective slides should be named accordingly:

BSS_Persev2024_Panache_SchoolName)

- An email including the choice of music should also be sent to the same email ID by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, July 26th, 2024.
- All songs chosen must not contain any explicit lyrics. Mixes and mashups are permitted. Music should be submitted in MP3 format.
- Participants must bring a backup pen drive with their MP3 soundtrack to the venue.

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Cultural Elements:

- Garments and accessories must incorporate identifiable cultural elements from the selected country/region.
- Cultural elements may include traditional textiles, patterns, motifs, colors, symbols, and historical references that are respectful and accurately represented.
- Teams should **demonstrate an understanding** of the cultural significance and context of the elements incorporated into their designs.
- Models can effectively present designs by incorporating cultural gestures, using creative accessories, coordinating with thematic music, engaging in a storytelling walk, showcasing transformation, utilizing props, set elements and collaborating in walks.

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- All teams must be present at Bombay Scottish School,
 Mahim on the day of the event 3rd August, 2024.
- Participants should be ready to walk the ramp half an hour before the event, including any last-minute touch-ups.

DRESS CODE

The dress code requires modesty and appropriateness:

- Necklines: Avoid plunging styles, opting for high necklines or modest V-necks.
- Sleeve Lengths: Cover shoulders with short, threequarter, or full-length sleeves.
- Skirt/Pant Lengths: Skirts below the knee, pants full-length; minimal slits and tailored fit.
- Overall Coverage: Adequate coverage without tightness or sheerness, with options for layering for modesty and fashion-forward designs.

GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION

Violation of Rules

- Non-compliance with competition guidelines, eligibility criteria, and design submission requirements.
- Failure to follow event rules, stage protocols, timing restrictions, or code of conduct.

Misrepresentation or Plagiarism

- Misrepresentation of cultural elements or offensive use of symbols.
- Plagiarism or unauthorized use of copyrighted materials.

Lack of Cultural Sensitivity

- Insensitive portrayal of cultural themes or stereotypes.
- Failure to showcase cultural diversity or appreciation for global fashion influences.

Unsportsmanlike Behaviour

- Disrespectful behavior towards organizers, judges, or participants.
- Cheating or unethical conduct during the event.

Disclosure of School Identity
