Come and take part in this high-energy face-off, and compete against fellow sharpshooters as every school battles for the win. If you think you're ready to light up our court with your skills and teamwork, we insist you join us in Basketball. So let that surge of adrenaline take over as you make that 3-pointer, and buckle up for the rush of the game.

RULES OF PROCEDURE

ELIGIBILITY:

- Category 1: Boys U16 and U19 combined.
- Category 2: Girls U16 and U19 combined.

RULES:

- Each school can send **only one team** per category.
- Each team must consist of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 players.
- The competition will be conducted on a knockout basis.
- In each game, the players will follow the **rolling substitution format** (where players can be substituted an unlimited number of times but only by informing the referee).
- The team must have a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 students from 9th and 10th grades, and a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 from 11th and 12th grades.
- The team must have **at least 2 players** from 9th/10th grades playing on the court at all times.
- Each game will be of 2 halves of 6 minutes each, with a 2-minute break. The <u>FINALS</u> will be 4 quarters of 6 minutes each, with a 2-minute break between each quarter.
- A basket <u>inside</u> the 3-point line will be worth 2 points, and a basket <u>outside</u> the 3-point line will be worth 3 points.

RULES OF PROCEDURE

AWARDS:

- 1. 1st Place Team
- 2. 2nd Place Team
- 3. 3rd Place Team
- 4. MVP (Most Valuable Player) of the Finals

FIRW OF AWANT

- Teams will be given a **specific team number** and on entry, they will know what time their matches will take place throughout the day.
- The qualification rounds along with the finals and the third place match will be held on **2nd August**, **2024**.

MARKING CRITERIA

- A higher number of points scored by the two participating teams within the time limit wins.
- The point system will follow the conventional basketball point system which includes 2-pointers and 3-pointers

DRESS CODE:

- Players must wear appropriate basketball attire.
- Each team **must carry two sets of jerseys**, both different colours (<u>all players from the same team must have the same 2 colours</u>).
- Anyone wearing their school jersey during the game will be disqualified.

RULES OF THE GAME:

- Any draws will result in the teams going into a freethrow shoot out where each team will take 3 free throws
 one player can take only one free throw.
- Conventional rules of basketball. No time-outs can be called. All calls made by the referees are final.

GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION

- Use of profane or obscene language.
- Engaging in physical altercations.
- Use of **prohibited substances**.
- **Disrespectful behaviour** towards other participants, teams, referees, and organisers.
- Failure to comply with event rules and guidelines.
- Disclosure of the identity of your school.
